

As a first step, we want to get to know you, so you need to send us an **Introductory letter**, either in a message to our Facebook page or to our e-mail address. The Introductory text must include the size of your residence (even by attaching photos of the apartment), your lifestyle, the amount of other animals, in short, all the information necessary to provide us with an insight into the kitten's future residence.

Through the pictures and videos on our website/Facebook page, you can get to know our Cattery, our kittens and their keeping conditions, but not only you want to get to know the Cattery and the cats and kittens, but we also want to know you. It is very important to us where and under what conditions our kittens end up, so it is necessary to send the Introduction text, because we do not give kittens anywhere, so getting to know each other is very important to us.

The other way to get to know each other is a **Personal meeting**, where you come to our Breeding and have the opportunity to get to know our Breeding in person, and we can get to know you through a short conversation.

There is always a fee for the visit, as we let you into our own home and we want to filter out frivolous inquirers. Of course, if a kitten is booked, the visit fee will be deducted from the booking amount.

Visiting a kitten - going in to their room and petting it - is NOT allowed for health reasons!

If there is mutual sympathy on the part of both parties and you still dream of an existing kitten, it is absolutely necessary to hand over/send the reservation on your part, because a kitten will only be reserved for you if the reservation has already been handed over or received. Before sending the deposit, you must, of course, approve the terms of the Purchase Agreement. **The deposit is NOT refundable if you cancel the selected kitten.**

If you want a kitten from future litters, but definitely from us, it is of course also possible to make an appointment. In this case, you can also register for a kitten, even of a given gender or color, by sending the reservation.

In both cases, you must pay the remaining amount before receiving the kitten or when you take it away.

Purchase Price

The purchase price of a kitten from our breeding depends on the kitten's bloodline, type, color/pattern and eye color. In the case of a favorite kitten moving outside of Hungary, the price is higher, as it involves additional costs (passport, rabies vaccination, staying longer, even neutering, etc.).

The purchase price includes, on the one hand, the quality bloodline of the kitten from abroad, the costs of its parents for their medical and genetic tests, and on the other hand, the kitten's own costs while it is growing in our cattery, such as quality food, canned food, nutritional supplements, vaccinations, other medical costs, deworming, chip, toys, litter, other equipment and, of course, its Pedigree. In addition to these, the purchase price includes the housing conditions and the high-quality, 13-year breeding work, as well as a "DS" starter package and 0-24 years of assistance and support.

In our cattery, the price is fixed, not negotiable, as we do not allow the conditions mentioned above. We do NOT give kittens without vaccinations or pedigrees. It is not possible to pay in installments!

Conditions

The kitten, if we consider it appropriate and its development is appropriate, will be ready to leave at the age of 11-12 weeks within the country (15-16 weeks outside the country with passport and rabies vaccination), with an obligation to be spayed or already neutered, of course with a vaccination book, 2 pieces of Purevax vaccinations, multiple deworm, chipped, Pedigree book, a 6-page sales contract, a receipt, a copy of the genetic tests of the parents, Breeder's guarantee and a smaller "DS" starter pack mentioned above.

Meaning of neutering obligation: Our cattery pays a lot of attention to ensure that our kittens are NOT bred by anyone, so we do NOT give kittens to Hungary for breeding. Our kittens are only given as pets, which means that you can NOT mate the kitten and you agree to have it neutered by the age of 8 months!

Ownership of the kitten and the associated Pedigree are our property as long as you do not neuter the kitten. After the neutering has taken place, we will mail the Pedigree to you in return for the vet's entry confirming the castration (shown in the vaccination book or passport) and a picture of the surgical scar.
