

Introductions and getting to know you

As a first step, we would like to get to know you a little better. To do this, please send us an introduction message either via our Facebook page or by email. In your introduction, please include the following details:

- The type and size of your home;
- Your lifestyle and daily routine/schedule;
- Who else lives in your household;
- Whether you have other pets (if so, please specify their breed and how many you have);
- Your previous experience with cat ownership;
- The living conditions and environment you can provide for the kitten.

Please also attach a few photos of your home so that we can get a clear picture of the kitten's future environment. On our website, as well as on our Facebook and TikTok pages, you can get to know our cattery, our cats, and their living conditions through photos and videos. Just as you would like to get to know us and our cats, it is equally important for us to get to know you. We want to ensure that our kittens go to loving, safe, and suitable homes, which is why this mutual introduction is a vital part of the process.



Reservation

Since 2026, our cattery is no longer open for preliminary visits. In the past, many people visited solely for sightseeing purposes. However, our cattery is also our family home, and we wish to preserve the peace, quiet, and safety of both our family and our cats. Transparency remains a top priority for us: the Gallery section of our website, along with our social media pages, features real, unedited photos and videos of our cats, kittens, and their living conditions. We strictly do not use AI-generated or AI-modified images on any of our platforms. Kittens can be reserved based on these photos and videos. Naturally, upon pick-up, you will be able to view the cat runs and our cats in person. If both parties feel a mutual connection after the initial introduction, and you have chosen an available kitten, the reservation becomes final upon payment of a deposit. Before transferring the deposit, we will send you the reservation agreement for that specific kitten, along with a draft of the sales contract (which will be signed in person upon pick-up).

The deposit should only be paid after you have reviewed and accepted these documents. A kitten is officially considered reserved once the deposit has cleared into our bank account. **Please note that if the buyer decides to withdraw from purchasing the selected kitten, the deposit is non-refundable.** The detailed terms regarding the deposit are always specified in the written agreement. If you would like to select a kitten from a future litter, a waiting list/advance reservation option is available. This reservation can be made for a specific gender or color. An advance reservation also becomes valid only upon a written agreement and the payment of a deposit. The terms, including the procedure in case a kitten of the desired gender or color is not born, are detailed in the agreement. **The remaining balance of the purchase price must be settled either prior to or, at the very latest, at the time of picking up the kitten.**

Purchase price

Please inquire about the purchase price of the kittens through one of the contact details listed below. The purchase price of a kitten depends on several factors, including its bloodline, type, color, pattern, and eye color. The price for kittens moving outside of Hungary may be higher, as preparing them for international travel involves additional costs. These may include, for example, a pet passport, rabies vaccination, an extended stay at the cattery, and, if applicable, neutering/spaying.

The purchase price is determined, on one hand, by the kitten's high-quality, international bloodline, the parents' medical and genetic testing, and their overall care costs. On the other hand, it covers the kitten's own expenses while growing up in our cattery: premium quality dry food and canned food, dietary supplements, mandatory vaccinations, other medical expenses, regular deworming, a microchip, toys, litter, supplies, and, of course, the official pedigree. In addition, the price reflects the outstanding living conditions provided here, our 14 years of high-standard breeding experience, the "DS" starter pack, and the 24/7 assistance and support provided to our owners. **Our prices are fixed and non-negotiable. We do not release kittens without vaccinations and their official pedigree. Installment payment plans are not available!**

Handover Conditions

Kittens moving within Hungary can expectedly go to their new homes at 11–12 weeks of age, while those moving abroad can do so at 15–16 weeks of age (in the latter case, with a pet passport and rabies vaccination). The exact date of handover is determined in every case based on the kitten's development, health status, and relevant regulations. Kittens are placed with their new families under a mandatory neutering/spaying obligation (or, upon special request, they may be neutered/spayed beforehand). For domestic relocations, a vaccination record booklet is provided, but a pet passport can also be issued upon request. At handover, the kitten will be twice-vaccinated, multi-dewormed, microchipped, and accompanied by an official pedigree, a 9-page sales contract, and an invoice. We also include copies of the parents' genetic test results, as well as the "DS" starter pack. The sales contract itself contains the breeder's warranty in accordance with the Hungarian Civil Code (PTK). In Hungary, our kittens are sold strictly for pet purposes only; breeding rights are not granted. This means that mating the cat is strictly prohibited, and the new owner agrees to have the kitten neutered/spayed by 8 (eight) months of age at the latest. The official pedigree will be mailed only after proof of neutering/spaying has been provided. The requirements for this proof are a formal veterinary entry in the vaccination record or passport, along with a photograph of the surgical incision site sent to us.
